


Enjoy one of the largest orchid growers in the Midwest, the largest equestrian arena in the state, Indiana's largest maple syrup producer, and Indiana's largest mural.

Forty 19th century covered bridges dot the countryside and scores of restaurants offer expansive and unique local food and drink. In **Greencastle**, some are nestled along tree-lined streets with awesome boutique shopping, handmade candies and ice cream, all walkable to **DePauw University**, with its **Peeler Arts Center**, **Green Performing Arts Center** and an incredible, wooded campus dating to the 1830s.



Music is everywhere, from the Roachdale Rib & Blues Fest to Music on the Square, to the Greencastle Summer Music Festival, plus two different weekly series all summer, a summer music festival, and bands in pubs and eateries year-round.

The historic architecture is remarkable. Eight historic districts highlight it, and **People Pathways** walks you through it. Great B&Bs, smart and funny innkeepers, second-story lofts, inviting campgrounds, and family-friendly hotels abound.

"Family" is the important word in The Putnam Inn Family Restaurant. Managed by the third generation of the family that started it, its four enormous food bars make it as popular for breakfast as it is for lunch and dinner. Almost Home Restaurant has been owned and managed by the same chef for more than 30 years. Lou's Diner is so busy with locals it's hard to get a seat for any meal, and it's strange that Bert & Betty's Kitchen is known for pie when so few have room for dessert.



Wide walking paths, biking paths, old-growth woods, ravines, creeks, and animals & plants of all kinds occupy a large portion of our topography that begins where Ice Age glaciers melted.

Indiana's hills, fun and memorable outdoor experiences start here.

Hobbit Gardens celebrates the solstices and equinoxes and offers workshops on growing, harvesting, using herbs, organics, weeds, edible landscape, plant medicine, and more.

The 500-acre **DePauw Nature Park** was the site of a limestone quarry. Bird watchers use it extensively, and its **Prindle Institute for**

Ethics and Bartlett Reflection Center provide beautiful, quiet places to enjoy the environment. The Manning Environmental Field Station and Rolland Welcome and Activities Center offer educational programs that make this not just another walk in the park.

Fortune Woods, part of the Big Walnut Nature Preserve, features a two-mile trail fittingly called Tall Timbers. Hikers pass through

old-growth stands of towering hardwoods, but the name overlooks one of the dog-friendly trail's most attractive features—a wealth of wildflowers along the Big Walnut Creek floodplain in spring.

Fern Cliff Nature Preserve, a registered National Natural Landmark, contains a mesic upland forest dominated by oak, beech, hickory, sugar maple, ash, wild cherry, tulip, and other

Big Walnut Nature Preserve / Fortune Woods

Tall Timbers, the two-mile looping trail through this National Natural Landmark, offers flat, wide paths to Big Walnut Creek, scenic ravines and old-growth beech, maple and oak. Wet feet are a possibility before staircases rise out of the valley. Expect abundant wildflowers in spring and, in summer, the chick-burr of scarlet tanagers. The Nature Conservancy maintains thousands of acres and has planted tens of thousands of trees in this preserve.

C Bar C Expo Center is Indiana's largest indoor equestrian facility, offering horse and livestock shows 48 weekends each year, a horse motel for travelers, with 500 10-by-10-foot box stalls, shavings, riding trails, and camping. Located just south of I-70, it is home to some of the most exciting and interesting

equestrian events in the U.S., nearly all with no admission charge.

A wooded, 62-acre primitive campground among farmland south of Greencastle, Camp Friend is open year-round, offering trails, a playground and basketball court. It's ideal for larger groups wanting an outdoor venue with bird-watching, star-gazing and lots of amenities of interest to active young people.

Open April 1 - December 22, this family-operated farm in Fillmore has nearly 200 varieties of apples, giving guests a wide and diverse selection. Near Putnamville, the 2,000-acre Deer Creek Fish and Wildlife Area, managed by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, features excellent hunting, fishing and hiking.

DePauw Nature Park

The layers of animal remains are observable in the walls of rock that began forming 350 million years ago in this 500-acre park that was an active limestone quarry. Included are outdoor classrooms, miles of trails, an amphitheater, and the Prindle Institute for Ethics. It and its Reflection Center host insightful programming year-round.

Fern Cliff Nature Preserve

West County Road 375 South Greencastle, IN 46135 317.232.4200

Lush ravines fill this 157-acre preserve, designated a National Natural Landmark. Owned by The Nature Conservancy, it contains a mesic upland forest with an understory of dogwood, hydrangea, pawpaw, and greenbriar. A botanist's floral paradise, particularly interesting is an abandoned sandstone quarry in the northern part of the preserve that is slowly filling with sphagnum moss.

Glenn Flint Lake LittleWalnutDistrict.IN.gov 765.739.6722

The 379-acre Glenn Flint Lake is home to game fish, particularly spunky panfish, channel catfish, largemouth bass, bluegill, and white crappie. The Indiana Department of Natural Resources Division of Fish and Wildlife manages the fishery at Glenn Flint, noting that "Bluegill fishermen do well in the spring, and the fall bite can be good, too."

Hall Woods Nature Preserve 3301-3727 East County Road 675 North 812.200.4040

Hall Woods is a State Nature Preserve. A microcosm of the Big Walnut Natural Area, of which it is a part, it includes a loop trail through a mature wood known for wildflowers, ferns and songbirds, and offers access to Big Walnut Creek, one of the highest-quality streams in the state.

One of Indiana's largest maple syrup producers, Harris Sugar Bush is open every day in syrup season – the last week of January through the first week of March. Tours year-round by appointment. Its log cabin store offers local foods, pancake and waffle mixes, maple cream and candy, and of course syrup from the sap of the farm's hard maple trees.

Lieber State Recreation Area-Cataract Falls / Cagles Mill Lake

This 8,000-acre state park features a 1,500-acre lake, campsites, swimming beach, swimming pool, and picnic areas. Three other state parks — Shakamak, McCormick's Creek, and Turkey Run, plus the Owen-Putnam State Forest — are within a 40-minute drive of Putnam County.

Portland Mills

On the Parke and Putnam county lines, once the thriving rural town of Portland Mills that was settled in the early 1800's, the low-traffic boat ramp offers easy launch for kayaks and canoes to access Raccoon Lake.

This 25-acre park features an Olympic-size swimming pool with water slide and diving well, the Emerald Palace super playground, picnic areas, lighted ball diamond and tennis courts, historic areas, and an architecturally stunning band shell.







Putnam Parks & Pathways

People Pathways, for walkers, joggers and cyclists, is part of the National Road Heritage Trail, revealing the unique beauty of Putnam County through a network of 17-plus miles of dedicated and shared routes in and around Greencastle. With a goal of developing connections within and between communities, highlights include the Greencastle to Fillmore Trail, the Sports Park link from the east side of Greencastle to Big Walnut Sports Park, a loop trail at Big Walnut Sports Park, and the Putnam Nature Trail.

Music makes this place hum year-round. ParkFest, for more than 25 years, attracts music lovers to free concerts in Robe-Ann Park. Roachdale's annual Rib & Blues Fest is a fall tradition blending great food and sound.

Eateries on Greencastle's tree-lined Courthouse Square have permanent stages. The permanent Courthouse stage is across from the performance/practice venue Music on the Square, opened by famed cellist Yo-Yo Ma, who performs regularly at DePauw University...which hosts the Summer Music Festival series of free concerts.

The Fret Set, an eclectic mix, gathers Thursdays outside The Fluttering Duck, inside the Inn at DePauw... which hosts Jazz at The Duck, in winter, and "Acoustic Sunsets," a summer series, on its outdoor patio.

Crown Street Music Festival, extensive year-round programming at DePauw's Green Center for the Performing Arts and the Putnam County Playhouse add theatre to the county's music scene. The stunning Peeler Art Center exhibits new and classic work by the country's most thought-provoking artists. The Putnam County Museum is a trove of rotating exhibits highlighting what makes this region so

remarkable. First Fridays bring thousands together to enjoy up-and-coming musicians, foods, arts.






