COVERED BRIDGE QUEST

Nine historic covered bridges make up the Covered Bridge Quest. Travel the length of the county and experience these century-old structures.

From Dick Huffman in the south to Cornstalk in the north, historic covered bridges are scattered across the Putnam County landscape. Enjoy the unique architecture, but be cautious. All of our covered bridges, except Houck Covered Bridge, are still functional and open to traffic.

NATURE PARK QUEST

The Nature Park Quest takes adventurers on a journey to six of the most popular outdoor locations in the county. Put on your hiking shoes and explore the trail systems while you're there.

Big Walnut Nature Preserve hosts two of the five locations, both Hall Woods and Fortune Woods. Just west of Greencastle is the DePauw Nature Park, and further west is Fern Cliff Nature Preserve. Travel south to explore Camp Friend and the Deer Creek Fish & Wildlife Area.

TIP: Signage can be found near the parking lots!



MURAL QUEST

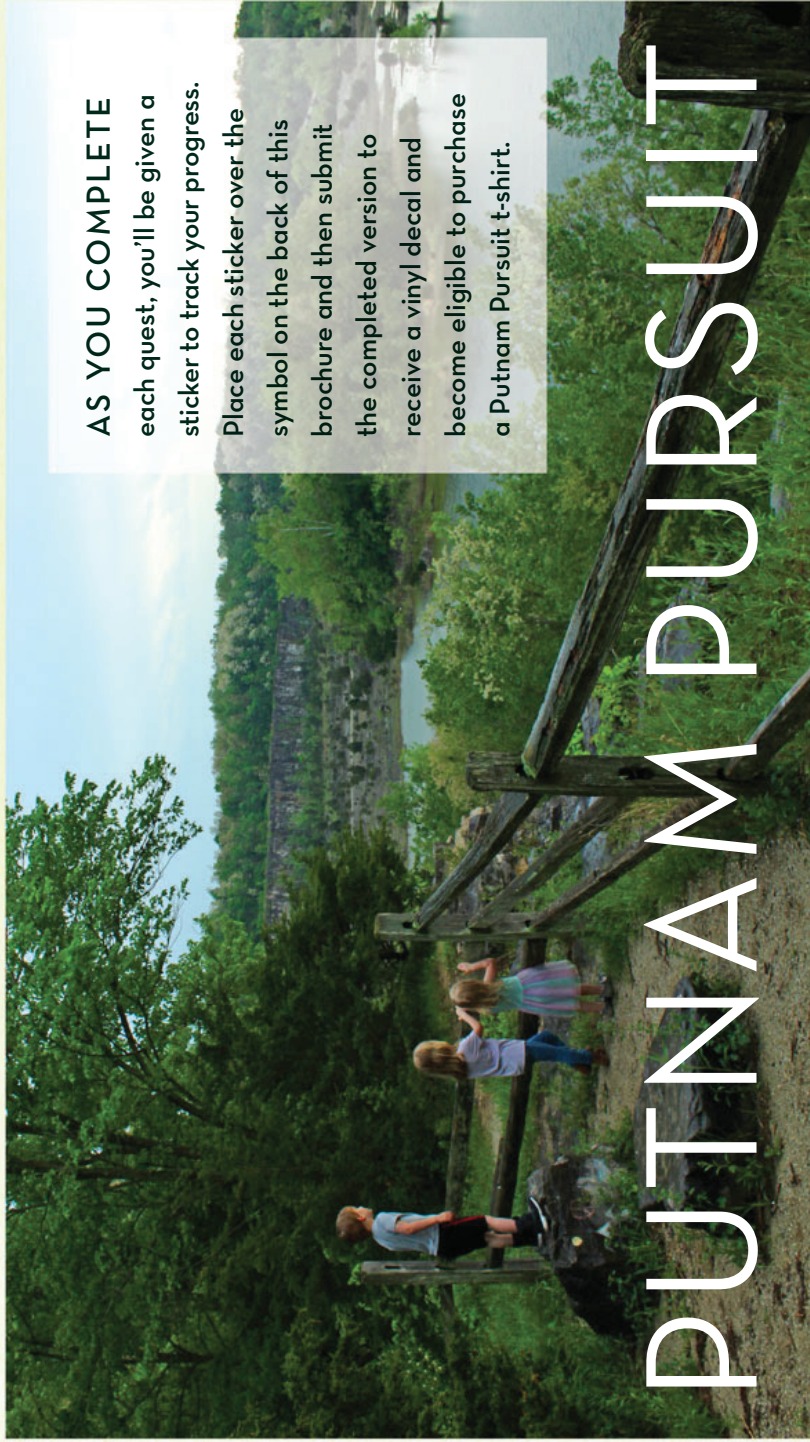
Eleven public, outdoor murals dot the landscape, including the "Silo Mural," the largest in Indiana.

An abundance of murals, including the largest in the State of Indiana, exist inside Putnam County. Stretching from Roachdale to Cloverdale, 11 murals are all publicly available and ready to be photographed thanks primarily to the efforts of the Putnam County Mural Project. Leading the effort through annual mural festivals, the Mural Project has added six murals in the last year alone.

TIP: All but one mural is located on a building!

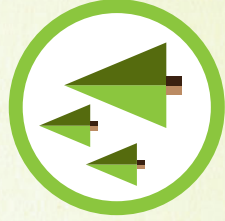
